1. Applicant declares that prior to filing this application he has ascertained the location of all existing utilities, both aerial and underground and the accurate locations are shown on the sketches.

A letter of notification was mailed on _____ to the following utilities:

2. It is expressly stipulated that this permit is a license for permissive use only and that the placing of facilities upon public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or vest any property right in said holder.

3. Whenever necessary for the construction, repair, improvement, maintenance, safe and efficient operation, alteration, or relocation of all, or any portion of said highway as determined by the Village Engineer, any or all, of said poles, wires, pipes, cables or other facilities and appurtenances authorized hereunder, shall be immediately removed from said highway or reset or relocated thereon as required by the Village Engineer, and at the expense of the permittee unless reimbursement is authorized.

4. All work shall meet Village standards and be performed under the supervision of Raymond C. Liggins, Jr., P.E., Village Engineer, located at 1050 Royal Palm Beach Boulevard, Florida, Telephone (561) 790-5162.

5. All materials and equipment shall be subject to inspection by the Village Engineer.

6. All Village property shall be restored to its original condition as far as partial, in keeping with Village specifications, and in a manner satisfactory to the Village.

7. All installations shall conform to the Village's Construction Specifications in effect the date permit is approved.

8. A sketch covering details of this installation shall be made a part of this permit.

9. The permittee shall commence actual construction in good faith within sixty (60) days from date of said permit approval and shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) days.

10. The construction and maintenance of such utility shall not interfere with the property and rights of a prior permittee.

11. Special conditions: Permittee must have a current effective registration as established by Ordinance No. 601.

12. Special instruction: _____

13. It is understood and agreed that the rights and privileges herein set out are granted only to the extent of the Village's right, title and interest in the land to be entered upon and used by the holder, and the holder will, at all times, assume all risk of and indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Village of Royal Palm Beach from and against any and all loss, damage, cost or expense arising in any manner on account of the exercise or attempted exercises by said holder of the aforesaid rights and privileges. 14. During construction, all applicable safety regulations shall be observed and the holder must take measures, including placing and display of safety devices, that may be necessary in order to safely conduct the public through the project area in accordance with the Florida Department of Transportation's Manual on Traffic controls and Safe Practices for Street and Highway Construction, Maintenance and Utility Operations.
15. The office of the Engineer designated in paragraph four (4) shall be notified twenty-four (24) hours prior to starting work and again immediately upon completion of work.
16. In case of non-compliance with the Village's requirements this permit is void and the facility will have to be brought into compliance or removed from the R.W. at no cost to the Village.
17. A copy of this approved permit must be on the job site at all times.
