Village of Royal Palm Beach Council Regular Meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. on June 1st.

The following actions were taken:

- Approved Budget Amendment for Fund 303 to transfer \$69,754.16 from GIS Update \$31,706.00, Canal System Dredging \$17,945.00 and Driving Range Shade Cover \$20,103.16 to Sparrow Pathway.
- Approved Change Order #6 in the amount of \$79,370.00 for the Sparrow Pedestrian Bridge and Bike Path Project with Interstate Construction, LLC.
- Approved First Addendum for Professional Services for Electrical Engineering Services provided by Electrical Design Associates through June 18, 2019.
- Approved First Addendum for Professional Services for Geotechnical & Environmental Engineering Services provided by Terracon Consultants, Inc. through June 18, 2019.
- Approved First Addendum for Professional Services for Surveying Engineering Services provided by Erdman Anthony through June 18, 2019.
- Adopted Ordinance No. 951 modifying the distance that boats and recreational vehicles must be parked back from the roadway in the front yards of residential lots.
- Approved Resolution No. 17-13 establishing an advisory committee in accordance with NFIP requirements for credit under the Community Rating System to develop a program for Public Information for flood related information.
- Appointed Carlton Brooks as an Alternate Member to the Recreation Advisory Board.
- Annual review and approval of a 5% merit pay for the Village Manager
