**Village of Royal Palm Beach
Rescheduled First Public Budget Hearing
was called to order at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 19th. The following actions were taken:**

- Announced proposed operating millage rate necessary to fund the budget is 7.43% above the rolled-back rate of 1.7872 mils.
- Announced the proposed operating millage rate is 1.9200 for the General Fund. Finance Director gave a summary of the tentative budget.
- Adopted proposed operating millage rate of 1.9200 for fiscal year 2017/2018.
- Adopted tentative Budget for fiscal year 2017/2018.
- Announced Final Budget Public Hearing for Thursday, September 28, 2017 - 7:00 p.m.
