was called to order at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 5th.
The following actions were taken:**

- Adopted Resolution No. 17-27 a revised Schedule of Fees and Charges.
- Approved Seasonal Vendor Permit for Our Lady Queen of Apostles Catholic Church to hold a Pumpkin Patch from October 15 thru October 31.
- Approved Special Event Permit for RPBHS to hold a Homecoming Parade on October 19th at 6:00 p.m. starting at the Recreation Center proceeding east down Sparrow Drive to high school.
- Approved 4 Special Event Permits for the Village to hold Movie Night/Food Truck Invasion at Commons Park. October 20th, December 15th, January 26th and February 23rd from 5:00 p.m. - 9:30 p.m.
