Village of Royal Palm Beach Council Regular Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 21st

The following action was taken:

- Rescheduled Budget Workshop from July 5th to coincide with Council Regular Meeting of July 19th. Cancelled the Council Regular Meeting of Thursday, August 2nd.
- Approved Special Events Permit for the Village to hold its Annual Star Spangled Spectacular at Commons Park on Wednesday, July 4th from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Approved a budget amendment for Fund 303 to transfer \$66,000.00 to increase Harvin Center Demolition (PW1801).
- Authorized the Village Manager to enter into contract with Almazan Construction LLC for demolition of Harvin Center not to exceed \$93,500.00 and with condition that the notice to proceed will not be prior to September 1, 2018.
- Approved Final Plat for Sparrow Place located at 138 Sparrow Drive.
- Approved Special Exception for 700 Royal LLC for an automobile and/or water craft repair and/or service station at 700 Royal Commerce Road.
- Approved Site Plan Modification and Architectural approval for a 6,852 sq ft commercial building with a restaurant and dental office located in the Southern Palm Crossing Shopping Center.
- Approved the Village Manager to enter into agreement with Lyft to provide a Transportation Assistance Program.
- Approved Young at Heart by-laws inclusive of a Senior Referral Program.
