Village of Royal Palm Beach Budget Workshop Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, July 19th

The FY 2019 Proposed Budget was presented.

Council Regular Meeting was called to order immediately following the Budget Workshop Meeting

The following action was taken:

- Tentative Adoption of Proposed Millage Rate of 1.9200 and Public Budget Hearings scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on September 6th and 20th.
- Approved a budget amendment for Fund 301 to transfer \$333,840.00 to Okeechobee Blvd. Lighting (EN1404).
- Approved a budget amendment for Fund 302 to transfer \$391,550.00 to RV Boat Parking II (EN1804).
- Approved bid award to Rohl Global Networks, LP for Okeechobee Blvd. Lighting for \$985,620.51.
- Approved bid award to Almazan Construction for RV Boat Parking Phase II for \$1,224,588.20.
- Approved "First Addendum for Park Maintenance Services" to L.V. Superior Landscaping, Inc. for \$50,106.00.
