First Budget Hearing
was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
Thursday, September 6, 2018**

The following action was taken:

- Announced proposed operating millage rate of 5.86% above the rolled-back rate of 1.8137 mils; announced proposed operating millage rate of 1.9200 for the General Fund ; adopted operating millage rate of 1.9200 for fiscal year 2018/2019; adopted tentative budget for fiscal year 2018/2019 and announced Final Budget Hearing—Thursday, Sept. 20, 2018.

**Council Regular Meeting
Immediately followed**

- Approved the purchase of two IBM Power9 (AS400) servers and professional services to upgrade IBM V7R1 serves HW/SW to V7R3, and migrate Superior (H.T.E.) Public Sector Administration software applications to new servers.
- Approved budget amendment for Fund 303 to transfer \$54,000 from Undesignated Fund Balance to Village Hall Outfall Replacement.
- Approved addendum to extend Traffic Calming Policy Development Services provided by Simmons & White for 2 years.
- Approved bid award in the amount of \$56,400 for the Village Hall Outfall Replacement with LCCI Construction.
- Approved contract in the amount of \$33,000 for website design, development, implementation and hosting services to Municode Web.
- Adopted Ord. 972 changing land use for 2 tracts of land totaling 4.93 acres from (LR-2,PBC) to (SF) on the south side of Southern Boulevard .27 miles west of SR 7.
- Adopted Ord. 975 amending Chapter 5 by adding new Section titled Retail Sale of Dogs and/or Cats which prohibits the retail sale of dogs and/or cats at pet stores, to provide exemptions & penalties and to provide a phase-out period.
