Village of Royal Palm Beach Final Public Budget Hearing was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, September 20, 2018

The following action was taken:

- Announced proposed operating millage rate of 5.86% above the rolled-back rate of 1.8137 mills; announced proposed operating millage rate of 1.9200 for the General Fund ; adopted final millage rate of 1.9200 for fiscal year 2018/2019 and Resolution No. 18-26; adopted final budget for fiscal year 2018/2019 and Resolution No. 18-27.

- Adopted Res. 18-28 a revised Schedule of Fees and Charges.
- Renewed annual software licensing and software maintenance support with Superior Public Sector, Inc. in the amount of \$60,000.
- Approved Third Addendum to Foreclosure Registry Services Agreement by and between Community Champions Corp and the Village.
- Approved Res. No. 18-24 and Modification to a Council Imposed Condition by Potter's House of WPB to expand and relocate within Royal Plaza South shopping center.
- Approved Res. No. 17-28 and Final Plat by K. Hovnanian Cypress Key, LLC.
- Approved first reading of Ord. 976 amending Chapter 26 definitions of "Bar and/or Cocktail Lounge" and "Restaurant" and create new definitions for "Nightclub" and "Live Entertainment" and delete "Restaurant, with Live Entertainment" as a Special Exception use in the CN-Neighborhood Commercial District.
- Approved first reading of Ord. 977 amending Chapter 22. Subdivision of Land.
- Approved first reading of Ord. 978 amending Chapter 26. Zoning adding a new Sec. 26-75.5 Art in Public Places.

- Approved first reading of Ord. 979 amending Chapter 2. Administration designating the P & Z Commission as the "Public Art Advisory Board".
- Appointment of Adam Miller as Alt. #2 to the Planning and Zoning Commission.
