

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In Conjunction with Application for a Permit for Structure(s) on Village Waterways

The undersigned property owner(s) submitted an application for a permit to construct a structure or structures on the waterways within the Village of Royal Palm Beach, Florida (the "Village") pursuant to Village Code Sec.7-18.; and Sub-paragraph (c)(2) of this section requires a fully executed hold harmless agreement to be included with the permit application if the structure is to be located on Village lands.
